

The project

« Impreuna pentru implicarea civica si constientizarea democratica intr-o Uniune Europeana multiculturala » was funded with the support of the European Union under the Programme "Europe for Citizens"

Participation: The project involved 150 citizens, notably 50 participants from the city of Slovakia, 50 participants from the city of Hungary and 50 participants from the city of Romania.

Location/ Dates: The event took place in **Livezeni Village, Romania**, from 21/08/2017 to 28/08/2017

The main achievement of the project was to help citizens to understand better the EU, its history and its diversity; by promoting European citizenship, civic and democratic involvement of citizens at EU level, having debates regarding the Europe's future and integration and adaptation to the concept of EU of citizens who have not been involved until now and who manifest aversion reactions about the EU.

In this regard, we organized debates, round tables and workshops on the topics mentioned above. We also conducted cultural, sport, recreational activities, touristic tours and presentations of specific forms of identity of the four communities.

The countries involved in the project were: Romania, Hungary and Slovakia. The number of the direct project participants was: 150 participants. From Livezeni – Romania were 50 participants, from Kamond Kozseg Onkormanyzata – Hungary were invited 25 participants, from Karakószörcsök Község Önkormányzata - Hungary were invited 25 participants and from Obec Sap – Slovakia were invited 50 participants.

Through the organized debates, round tables and workshops, the 150 participants realized the EU concept, they were informed about the importance and role of cooperation between Member States, they showed interest in promoting European citizenship, civic and democratic involvement at European Union level, and also they were involved to participate actively in activities which aim was to improve the future of Europe.

The project had a positive impact in short term but will definitely have a medium and long term impact for the participating communities, through the fact that it will help to improve partnership between these 4 communities by contributing to information and awareness of participants on key aspects of the EU. As well, the impact will be on other organizations from different countries as well, that by following the present model, will initiate such programs, helping to build a united Europe, an Europe based on efficient political and civic principles and on involvement and participation of citizens in improving the future of their communities.
